The picture to the left is of a rooftop horizontal lifeline system supported by CB18 rigid anchors from Guardian. The customer recently installed a new roof hatch, so the horizontal lifeline system had to be re-routed around this new hatch. SES was able to cut and splice this cable, install four new 90degree corner units and reinstall the horizontal lifeline system to provide perimeter fall protection for the customer on this rooftop.

The 3D model to the right was put together for an access platform to inspect open bed trucks at a poultry management company in Nebraska. SES will design, furnish and install this platform, which is 40' long, three feet wide and sits eight feet off the floor. This 3D model allowed our customer to understand fully what we were proposing and was significant in their decision to issue SES a contract for this Work.
